Intersection of behavioral and physical health under Medicaid

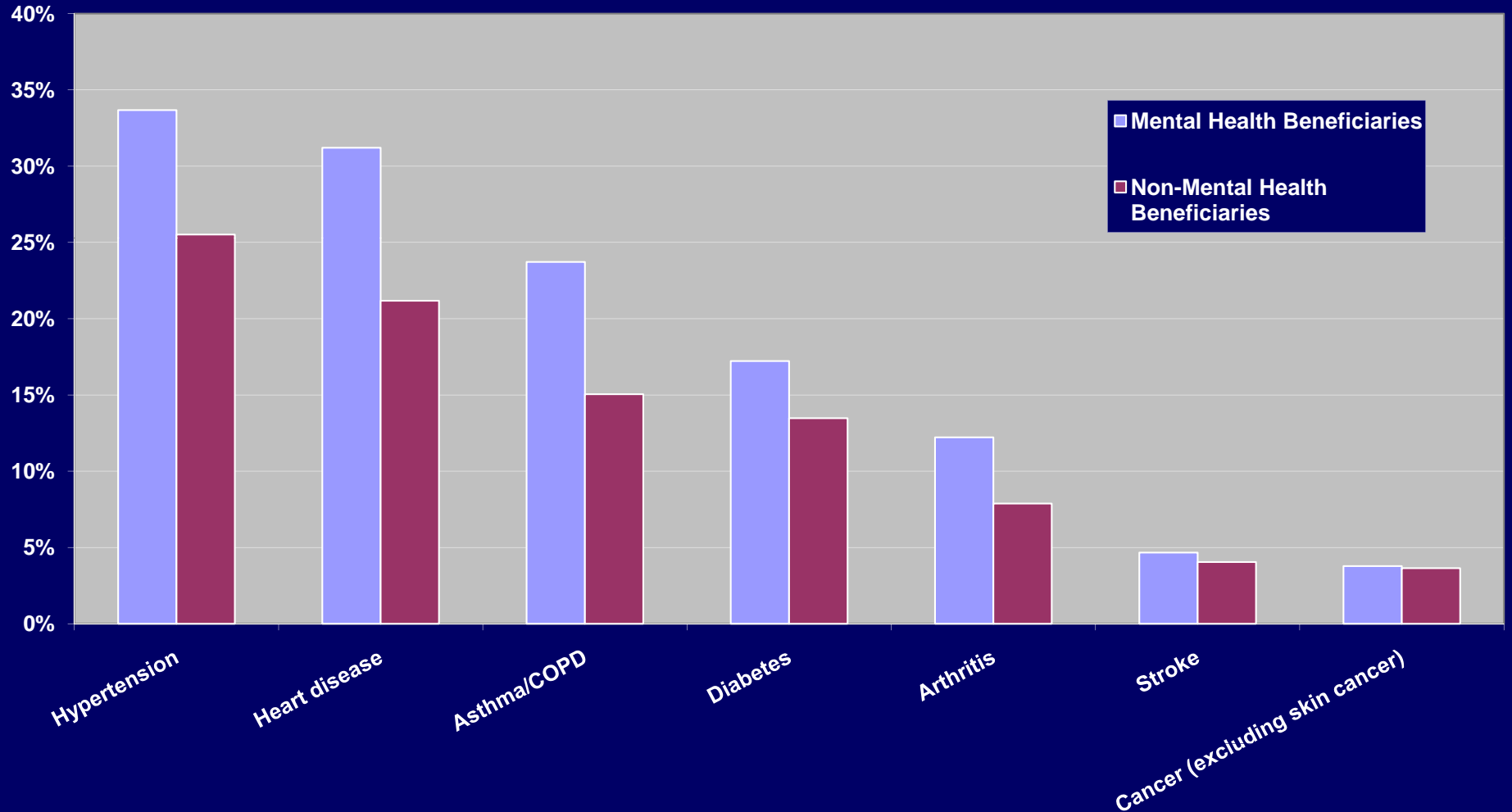
- **Sample: adults with full year of FFS enrollment (includes disabled adults; does not include duals)**
 - **332,000 beneficiaries**
 - **\$20,400 per capita**
 - **\$6.8 billion in spending**

- **Mental health diagnosis or claim**
 - **117,000 beneficiaries (35% of cohort)**
 - **\$28,500 per capita (vs. \$16,000 for comparison group)**
 - **\$3.3 billion in spending (49% of cohort)**
 - **\$0.8 billion (24%) for mental health services**

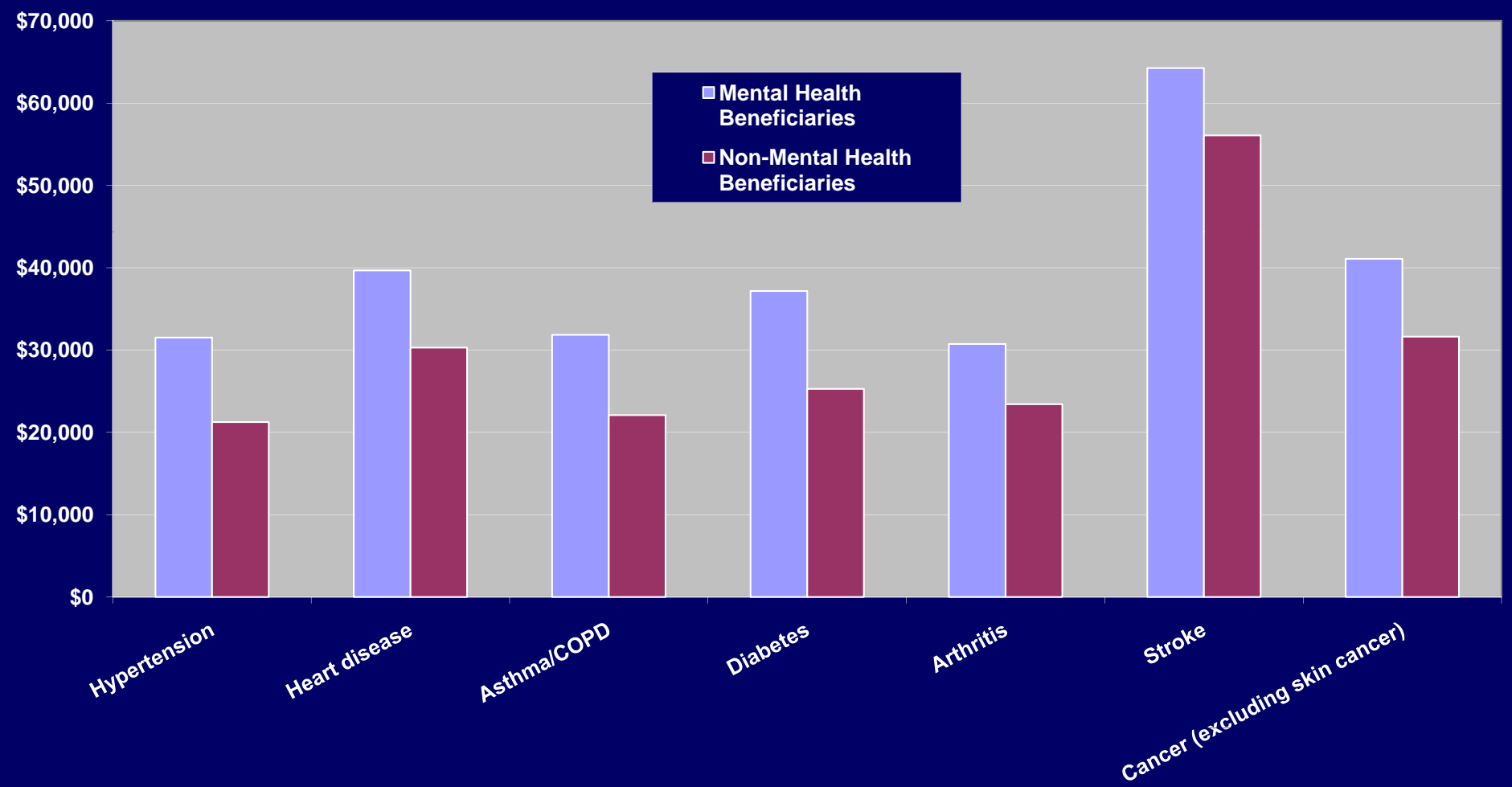

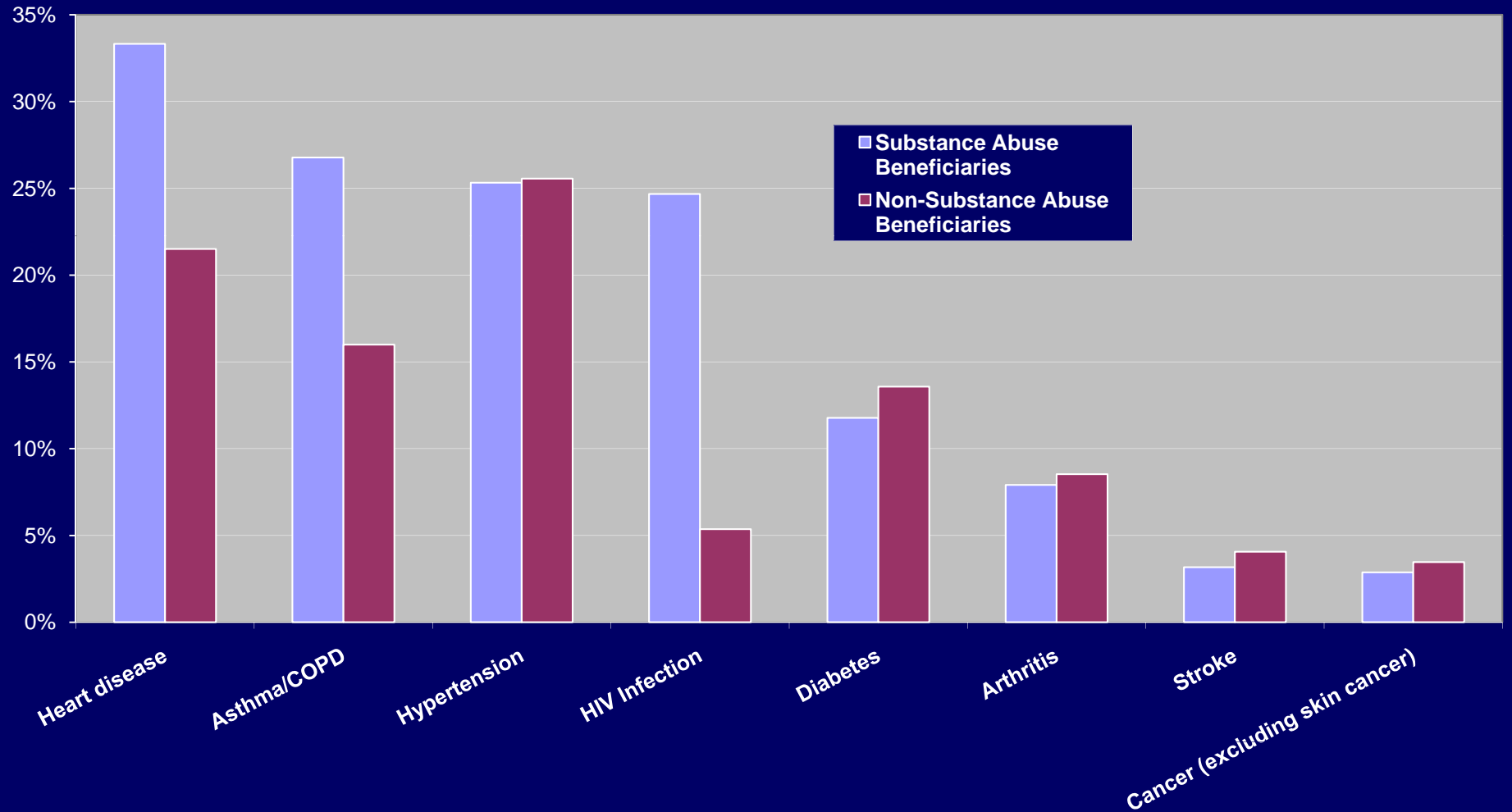
Prevalence of Selected Co-morbidities by Mental Health Status
